

Campsite Rules

Camping Haliotis

1) Admission conditions

To be admitted to enter, to settle in, and to stay in the campsite, you have to be authorized to do so by the manager or his representative. He is in charged of the security and order of the campsite, and also of the application of the present rules.

The fact of staying at Haliotis Campsite means that you accept the present rules and that you engage yourself to comply with them.

2) Police formalities

Anybody staying at least one night at the campsite must produce an Identity card or passport to the manager or his representative and comply with the formalities requested by the police.

Minors travelling without parents will not be admitted unless if they can produce a written authorization from their parents.

The tent, the caravan or the motorhome and any material attached to it have to be installed in the pitch indicated and in accordance with the directives given by the manager or his representative.

3) Reception

Open as from 7.30 until 22.00

You will find at the reception all the information about the services at the campsite, information about sport's installations, the touristic activities of the region and many addresses you could need.

A complaints book or a special box for complaints is at your disposal at the reception.

Complaints will be accepted only if they are signed, dated, as detailed as possible and relating to recent facts.

4) Fees

Fees are paid at the reception desk. Their amount is noticed at the entrance of the campsite and at the reception.

They are due according to the number of nights spent at the campsite.

Campsite users are invited to inform the reception of their departure the day before their departure.

5) Noise and Silence

Please, campsite users have to avoid to make noise or discussions which could disturb their neighbours.

Sonorized equipments have to be used respecting the tranquility of the neighbours. Please, respect this tranquility also when you shut the doors of the mobil homes, chalets or cars, caravans, motorhomes.

Silence must be total between 22.00 and 7.00.

It is forbidden to let dogs and other animals free in the campsite. They can not be let at the campsite, even shut in a vehicule or in a mobilhome/chalet, during the absence of their owner who is civilly responsible of them.

6) Visitors

After having been authorized by the manager or his representative, visitors can be admitted at the campsite under responsibility of the campers who are receiving them.

The camper can receive one or several visitors at the reception. If those visitors are authorized to enter the campsite, the camper who is receiving them can be asked to pay a fee, as the visitor is getting access to the facilities of the campsite. This fee is mentioned at the entrance of the campsite and at the reception.

Visitor's cars are forbidden in the campsite.

7) Traffic and parking of vehicles

Inside the campsite, vehicles speed limit is 10 km/h.

Traffic is forbidden between 22.00 pm and 07.00 am.

Camper's vehicles are the only authorized to be in the campsite.

The parking must not disturb the traffic neither stop or disturb the installation of new campers.

8) Equipment and facilities

Everybody is asked to avoid any action which could harm the cleanliness and the appearance of the campsite and his facilities/equipment, notably toilet facilities.

It is forbidden to throw drainage water on the floor or in the gutters.

“Caravaniers” must empty the drainage water in the equipment provided for it.

Household waste and rubbish of any type, papers, have to be thrown in the bins.

Washing is completely forbidden outside the place provided for it.

Hanging out the linen will be done at the communal dryer. However, it will be accepted until 10.00 am close to the shelters, on the condition that it will be very discreet and not disturb the neighbours. It will never be done as from the trees.

Flowers and plantations must be respected. It is forbidden to plant nails in the trees, to cut branches, to do plantations.

It is not allowed either to delimit a pitch by personal means, neither to dig the ground.

Any deterioration made to vegetation, to closures, to the ground or to the equipment of the campsite will be paid by the perpetrator of the deterioration.

The pitch which will have been used during the stay will have to be restituted in the same condition as it was when the camper arrived.

9) Security

a- Fire

Open fires are strictly forbidden.

Stoves have to be maintained in perfect working condition and must not be used in dangerous circumstances.

Extinguishers are usable in case of necessity. In case of fire, inform immediately the management.

A first aid kit is at your disposal at the reception.

b- Robbery

The management is responsible of the property leaved at the reception and has a general obligation of surveillance of the campsite. The camper keeps with the responsibility of his own equipment and must inform the management about the presence of any suspect person.

Even if the caretaking is insured, the campers are invited to take the usual precautions to secure their equipment.

10) Games

No violent or disturbing game can be authorized nearby the equipment of the campsite. The meeting room can not be used for stormy games. The children must always be under supervision of their parents.

11) "Garage Mort"

It will be possible to leave unoccupied equipment at the campsite only after agreement of the management and only on the indicated pitch.

A fee, which amount will be noticed at the reception, may be due for this service.

12) Display

The present rules are displayed at the entrance of the campsite and at the reception. They are given to the customer on request.

13) Offence to the Campsite Rules

In the case of a camper would perturb the stay of other campers or would not respect the arrangements of the present campsite rules, the manager or his representative will be able, orally or by writing if it is necessary, to give him notice to stop the troubles.

In case of serious or repeated offence to the present campsite rules and if the manager have to give somebody notice to stop the troubles, the manager will be able to cancel the contract.

In case of penal offence, the manager may call the police force.

14) Extras

Due to the nature of the campsite's ground and also to its structure, caravans equipped with twin axles, and trucks of more than 3.5 tonnes are not allowed to park at the campsite.
